navegar (por Internet)	belongs to the -AR group of verbs
cantar	belongs to the -AR group of verbs
bailar	belongs to the -AR group of verbs
sacar (fotos)	belongs to the -AR group of verbs
mandar (mensajes)	belongs to the -AR group of verbs
tocar (la guitarra)	belongs to the -AR group of verbs

The form of the verb which ends in **-AR** is known as the **infinitive** and always means **TO** _____

You have met this verb form in the construction:

me gusta **navegar** por Internet etc
I like **TO SURF** the Internet
